Sandra Harris-Hooker, Ph.D

Senior Vice President for External Affairs and Innovation

Dr. Harris-Hooker began her career earning a degree in Biology from Dillard University. Subsequently, she went on to earn her Ph.D. in Developmental Biology from Atlanta University (now called Clark Atlanta University). Upon completion off her PhD, Dr. Harris-Hooker spent three years in the Cardiovascular Research Fellowship Program at the University of Washington School of Medicine. Following her postdoctoral training, she served on the faculty of the Department of Pathology at Boston University School of Medicine before joining the faculty in the Department of Pathology and Anatomy at Morehouse School of Medicine. She currently serves as Senior Vice President for External Affairs and Innovation.

Dr. Harris-Hooker's primary research interest is in Cardiovascular Pathology with an emphasis on the pathogenesis of atherosclerosis. Further, she is also interested in ways by which to enhance the integration of basic, clinical, and population-based research to address disparities in health.

Dr. Harris-Hooker has been instrumental in directing or facilitating several institutional research programs at MSM which have aided in enhancing the research training and research infrastructure for student trainees and faculty. These programs include the Research Training Initiative for Student Enhance (RISE), the Research Centers in Minority Institutions RCMI), the Clinical Research Center (CRC), the Cardiovascular Research institute (CVRI), and others. She is a member of several local and national boards in a continued effort to move impactful initiatives from health disparities to health equity.

She has also been a member of several professional organizations and served in an advisory capacity on several external committees such as the Journal Ethnicity and Disease Editorial Board, NASA-Biomedical Research Institute, Association for the Accreditation of Human Research Protection Board of Directors, Association of Minority Health Professions Member, YMCA Villages at Carver Board of Directors, American Heart Association Research Committee, Executive Leadership in Academic Medicine, among others.





Morehouse School of Medicine Learning Communities

A learning community is a group of individuals sharing common goals, values, and ideas that actively engage in learning with and from each other.

Our Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) project, entitled "Mentoring Students at Morehouse," began in the fall of 2011. The QEP project was developed strategically to align with initiatives to expand the Institution's educational programs and sustain the highest standards of teaching, excellence, and professional competence. Its primary objectives are to train faculty mentors, mentor academically challenged students, and mentor all students through learning communities.

Learning communities are student-led and mentor-facilitated educational sessions that take place in a supportive team environment.

The expected outcomes of learning communities are:

- Improvement of learning outcomes for our students, including skills, grades, scores, and time to degree;
- Development of long-term supportive relationships through mentoring sessions, and
- Development and/or enhancement of faculty members' skills and capacities as mentors.

All Morehouse School of Medicine students are grouped into learning communities.

Medical students (MD) are grouped into the 12 learning communities of Knowledge, Innovation, Compassion, Wisdom, Excellence, Leadership, Integrity, Service, Commitment, Discovery, Equity, and Inclusion.

Students in the Master of Science in Physician Assistant Studies (MSPAS) are placed across three learning communities: Justice, Honor, and Service. Each community is also identified by a corresponding name of a pioneering African-American physician or physician assistant: Richard Smith, MD; Joyce Nichols, PA-C; and Prentiss Harrison, PA-C, respectively.

Graduate students in biomedical sciences are grouped by the degree levels of Doctor of Philosophy in Biomedical Sciences (PhD); Master of Science in Biomedical Research (MSBR); Master of Science in Biotechnology (MSBT), MSBT with Medical Cannabis Therapeutics Concentration, Master of Science in Health Informatics (MSHI); Master of Science in Clinical Research (MSCR); Master of Science in Medical Sciences (MSMS); and Master of Science in Neuroscience (MSNS).

Graduate students in public health are grouped by the degree levels of Doctor of Health Administration (DHA), Master of Administration in Justice-Involved Care (MAJIC) and the Master of Public Health (MPH) students also participate in learning communities that are grouped by life stages.

International Declaration of

HEALTH RIGHTS

Health requires peaceful and equitable development and collaboration of all peoples.

The enjoyment of the highest attainable standard of health is one of the fundamental rights of every human being. It is not a privilege for those with power, money, or social standing.

Health is more than the absence of disease, but includes prevention of illness, development of individual potential, a positive sense of physical, mental, and social well-being.

Health care should be based on dialogue and collaboration between citizens, professions, communities, and policy makers.

Health service should be affordable, accessible, effective, efficient, and convenient.

Health begins with healthy development of the child and a positive family environment.

Health must be sustained by the active role of men and women in health and development. The role of women and their welfare must be recognized and addressed.

Health care for the elderly should preserve dignity, respect, and concern for a sustainable environment with balanced human populations growth and preservation of cultural diversity.

Health depends on the availability to people of basic elements: Food, safe water, housing, education, productive employment, protection from pollution, and prevention of social alienation.

Health depends on protection from exploitation without distinction of race, religion, political-belief, economic or social condition.
